On your mark, get set, SLOW DOWN. The speed limit in most residential neighborhoods is 25 MPH but many people feel that is still too fast. We want to lower the speed of traffic through our neighborhood to a more reasonable speed. We think "20 Is Plenty!".

We don't want to change the law and we don't necessarily want the police to hand out tickets. We just want everyone to voluntarily slow down.

Several years ago, another neighborhood launched a voluntary "Slow Down" campaign and the results were dramatic. Over 90% of the neighborhood participated and agreed to place a yard sign in their front yard asking drivers to slow down.
